Using the story of "Resurrection" for a loose base to work from, these elements will be included:

Possibly use two Vortices interconnecting and dropping the Sliders and Rickman onto the island.

Add a teenage boy who's duplicitous. Either helping us or helping Rickman. We're not sure. It'll be revealed that the boy is one of the scientist's experiments. We'll feel sorry for him and it'll be a strange twist when he turns out to be a conniving snit.

Backstory on Maggie and Rickman could be that she and Rickman were in love. Maggie was going to leave Steven for Rickman and then Steven had his accident. She visited every day in hospital, breaking it off with Rickman and then married Steven. Rickman never took the rejection well. Maggie thinks part of the reason Rickman killed Steven was to finally get back at him and her...

The end of the show will be a Quinn and Rickman showdown. Quinn will be in a position to kill him, but won't. He doesn't need to. All he needs is the timer and then they'll have their home coordinates. Rickman will be left behind with nothing more than a few mutants to suck brain fluid from. As far as Rickman's concerned, Quinn should just kill him. But Quinn won't. Besides, killing Rickman could endanger getting his timer.

Maggie's lust for revenge though gets in the way and she kills Rickman. He tumbles over a sea cliff and disappears into the water -- taking his timer with them and their hopes of getting home.
